



# Understanding the Elements of Methodize

Methodize is a feature-packed course management system designed to help students build mastery of the subjects being taught. Instruction in Methodize is delivered through the following elements:

**Units:** Units break the long courses into shorter, manageable blocks. The work does not have to be done sequentially: students can choose to do the work in the order listed, or jump to other units whenever they want.

**Lessons:** Lessons provide a mix of text and audio instruction. Lessons also are likely to have one or more example questions for students to engage with to test their comprehension of the concepts being taught.

**Quizzes:** Every lesson has at least one multi-question quiz attached to it. These quizzes are timed, and students will have a chance to review detailed text **AND** video explanations of the right answers.

Methodize also contains other tools that students can use to improve their mastery of the material being taught. Those tools include:

**Evaluation Tests:** These consist of the exact types of questions students will see on the real test, but the Evaluation Tests are much shorter, and each section can be completed in less than 20 minutes. Students will receive a score scaled just like the real test.

**Full-length Tests:** Each course contains two full-length tests providing students an authentic practice experience

**Vocabulary Builder:** A flash-card game that students can use to get familiar with the kind of "college level" vocabulary found in the reading passages of the ACT and SAT.

**Resources:** This is where users can find helpful information about the tests, help documents about Methodize and other useful items.
