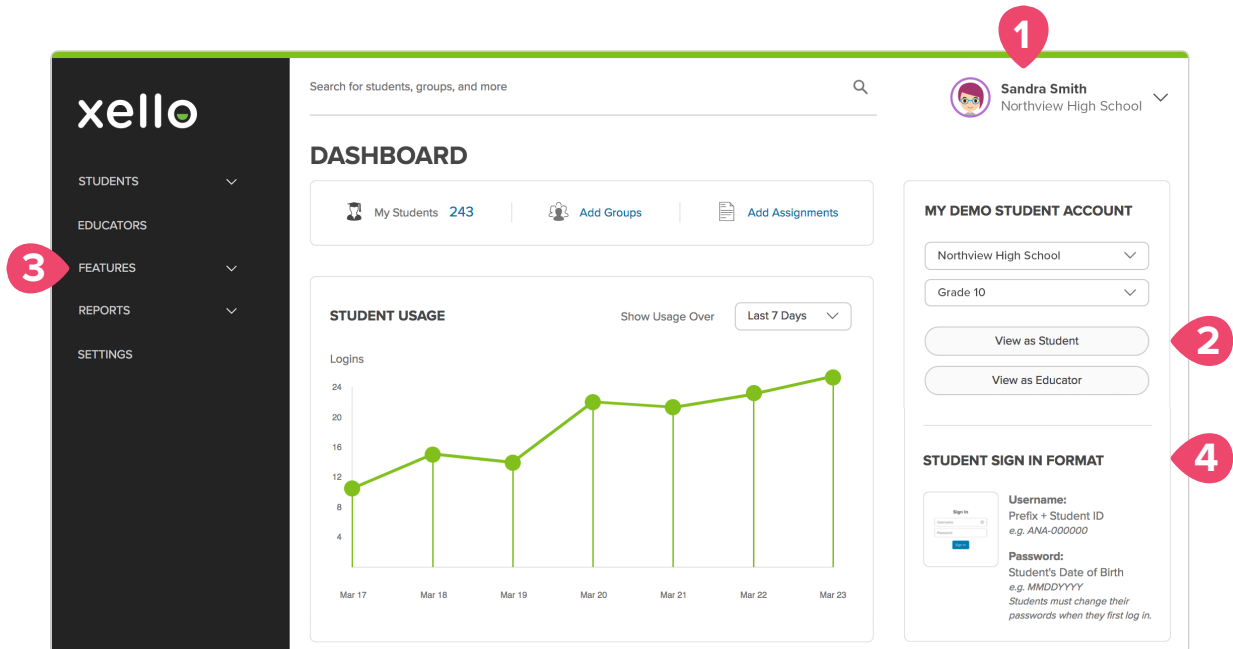




Let's get started!

Sign in to Xello using the credentials you received via email or through single sign-on. Once you're in your account, here are a few simple steps to help get you started with Xello and on your way to becoming a future-ready hero!



1. Personalize your account

Click on your name in the top right corner. Then click on *Profile* in the drop down menu. This is your Educator Profile page. Give it some personality by clicking on *Change* below the default icon and uploading any picture you want—after all, this is your space!

3. Get inspired by exploring lessons

Become familiar with Xello's fully integrated lessons. Click *Features* in the left navigation, then *Lessons*. Click on each lesson title for an overview of the content. 2. Experience what your students experience

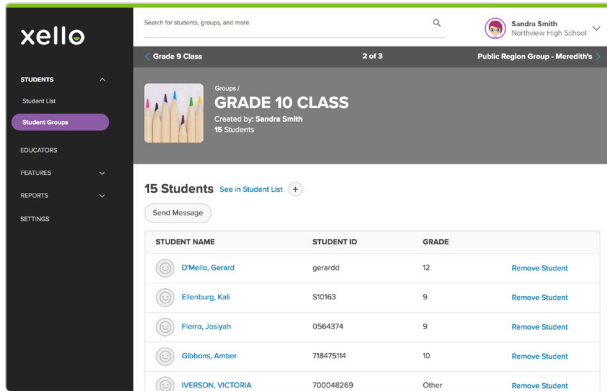

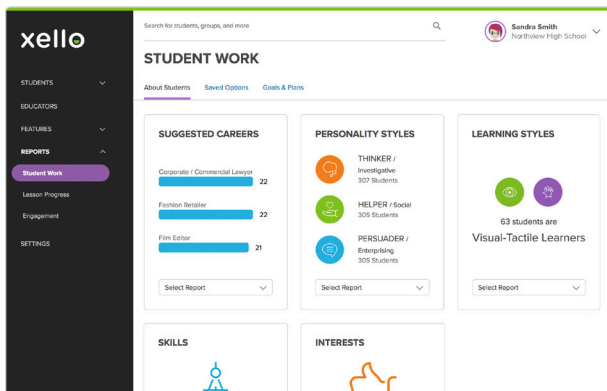

Organize your students into groups based on classes, clubs, or any other factor you find helpful. Use your groups to create assignments, review work and run reports.

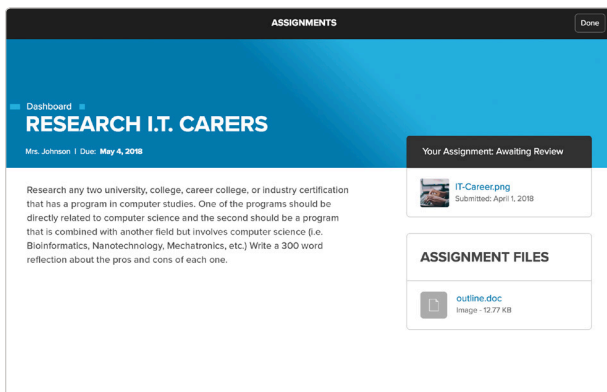
